

The third largest country in Europe, Sweden offers a diverse range of sights.

The **Sweden Eurail Pass** is a flexi pass valid for unlimited travel on any **3, 4, 5, 6 & 8 days** in **1 month**. Travel days may be used consecutively or non-consecutively.

A day of rail travel is a 24 hour period from midnight to midnight. This allows for unlimited travel on any number of trains for each day of use.

Sweden Eurail Pass Information

Malmo is home to incredible art galleries and progressive design. The capital Stockholm hands out prizes for peace and is known for its socially equality. In Northern Lapland, the Sami people still herd reindeer for sustenance.

Things to note:

- To start using the pass it must be validated at a European train station before your first journey.
- Each further day of travel must be entered on your pass before you board the train.
- **Free Child Offer:** Two children aged 4-11 years inclusive travels free for each paying adult. The free child offer must be requested at the time of booking the adult pass. The free child offer is NOT valid in conjunction with a Senior or Youth fare. Additional children aged 4-11 years purchase a Youth fare. Children under 4 years travel free if not occupying a seat / bed. Seat reservation fees still apply.

Please note: A Sweden Eurail Pass is valid with the national railway company SJ and also valid on the following private railway lines:

- Direct SJ trains to and from Copenhagen and Copenhagen Airport
- Direct border crossing trains from Göteborg and Stockholm to Oslo

Payment & Ticketing

Conditions:

- Residents of Europe, UK, Turkey and North Africa (Algeria, Morocco and Tunisia) are not eligible to purchase or use a Sweden Pass.
- Passes must be validated within 11 months of issuing date by a railway official in Sweden.
- Passes must be validated prior to boarding the first train or first use of a bonus offer.
- **Free Child Offer:** Two children aged 4-11 years inclusive travels free for each paying adult. The free child offer must be requested at the time of booking the adult pass. The free child offer is NOT valid in conjunction with a Senior or Youth fare. Additional children aged 4-11 years purchase a Youth fare. Children under 4 years travel free if not occupying a seat / bed. Seat reservation fees still apply.
- Seat reservation fees are an additional charge and not inclusive in the cost of the pass.
- Comprehensive conditions of use can be found on the ticket cover.

We also recommend that you take out suitable travel insurance to cover (as a minimum) the costs incurred if you cancel your trip.

Cancellation & Amendments

Conditions:

- A \$20 per pass fee applies for amendments to unused passes returned within one year of issuing date.
- Passes must be presented for refund unused and not validated.
- A fee of \$30 per person, per pass applies to totally unused passes returned within one year of issuing date.
- No partial refunds.
- Eurail Passes cannot be reissued if lost or stolen.
