Departing from Poroy Station near Cusco at 09h05, the Hiram Bingham, named after the archaeologist who discovered the ancient Incan city of Machu Picchu, offers a more leisurely start to the day than traditional departures. Brunch is served onboard and guides are present to explain points of interest enroute, as well as in the remains on arrival at the ancient citadel. An afternoon tea is served in the Machu Picchu Sanctuary Lodge located just steps from the entrance to the citadel, and once back on board for the 17h50 departure, pre-dinner cocktails are served, accompanied by live entertainment, and afterwards a 4 course, à la carte dinner is presented in the dining cars.

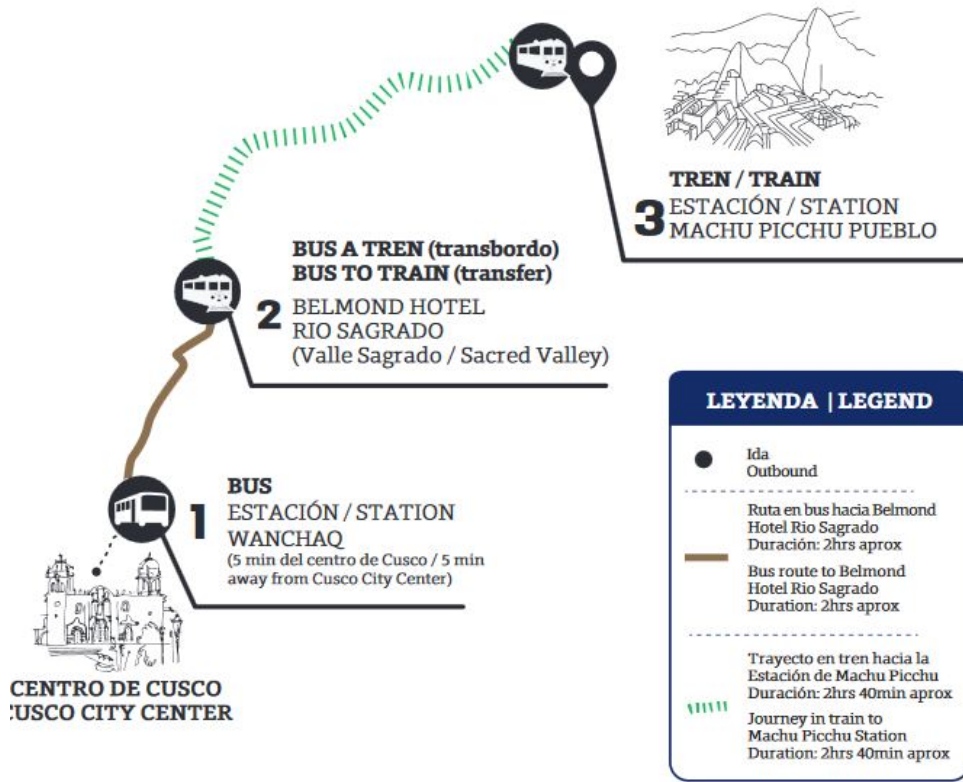

Bi-modal timetable: Jan 2nd - Apr 30th, 2019

Between Jan 2 and Apr 30, 2019, PeruRail operates a Bimodal Service (Bus + Train) that combines bus and train travel.

Passengers travel on the Belmond Hiram Bingham bimodal service board a private bus at Wanchaq Station, 5 minutes away from Cusco's historic center, and arrive to Belmond Hotel Rio Sagrado. From the hotel, join the Belmond Hiram Bingham train for the journey to Machu Picchu Station. On the return leg, passengers are dropped off at their accommodation in Cusco's city center. The Belmond Hiram Bingham train operates daily except for the last Sunday of every month. Regular services departing from and arriving into Ollantaytambo or Urubamba Stations will not be affected.
